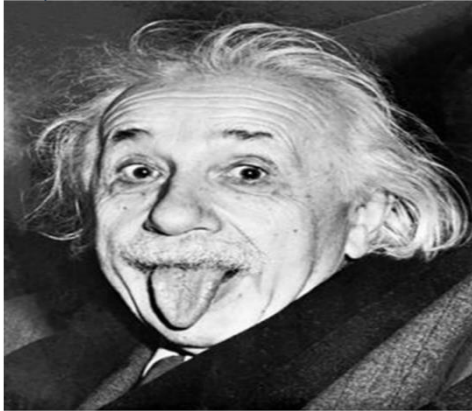

“This is an emotional fire that drives an individual to work so hard, and in such a focused, deliberate way in order to achieve extra-ordinary performance”

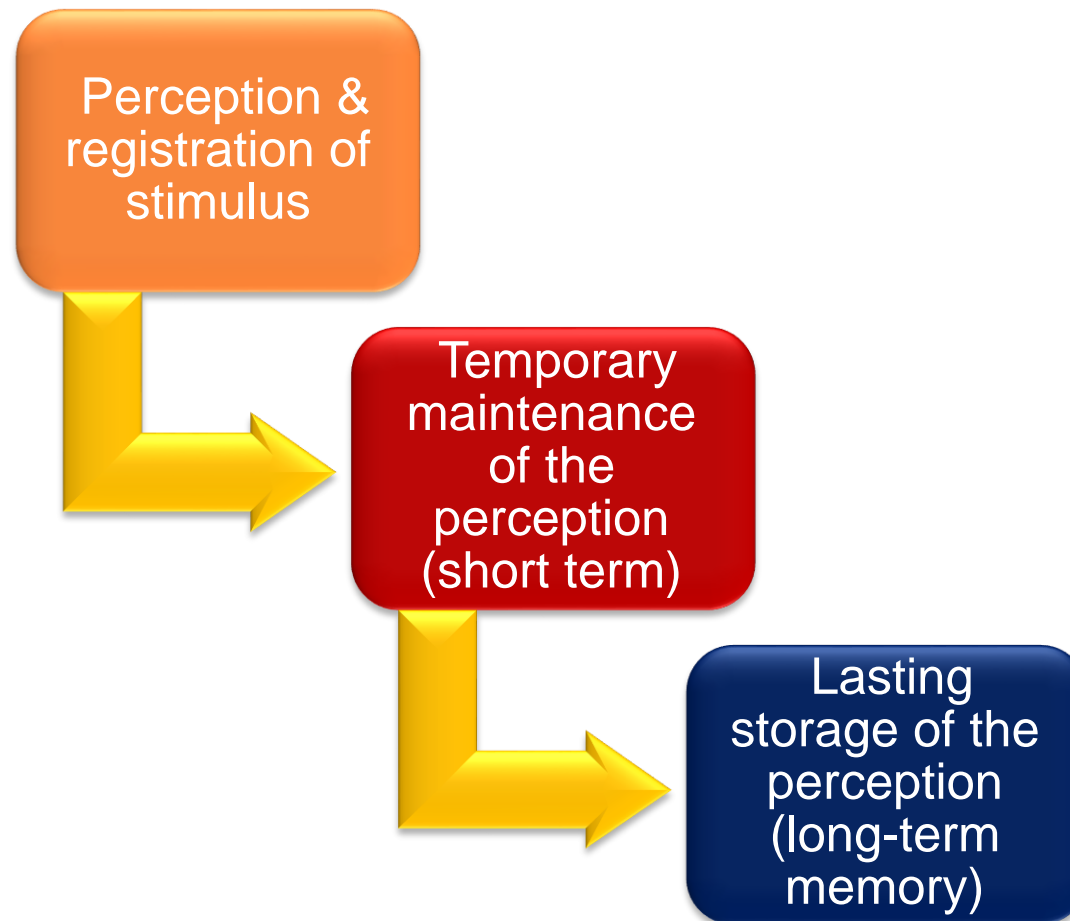
- **What ignites strong, long-lived passion?**

Memory in psychology is defined as

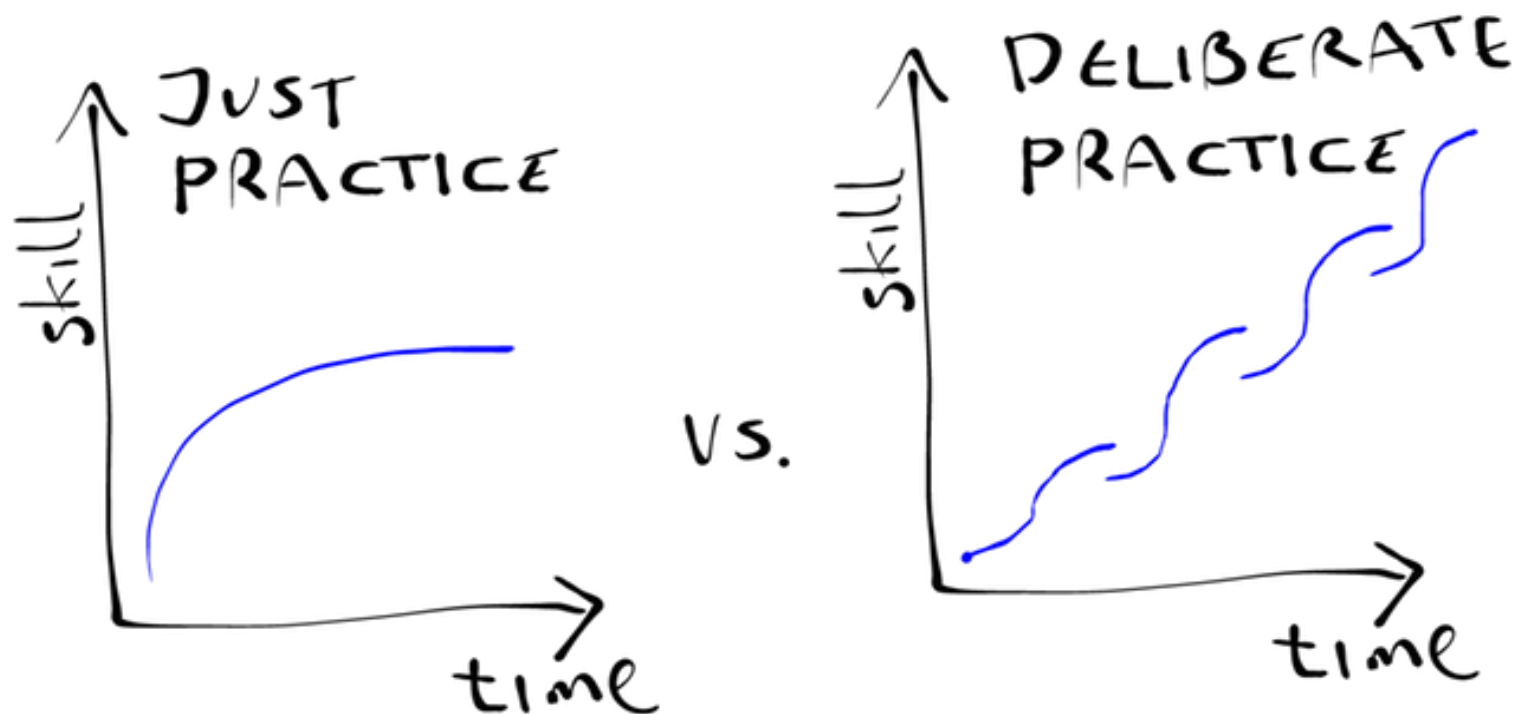
“the storing of learned information, and the ability to recall that which has been stored.





Deliberate Practice

Deliberate Practice

- It is estimated that by the time Mozart was aged 6, Mozart had already practiced for a total of 3,500 hours





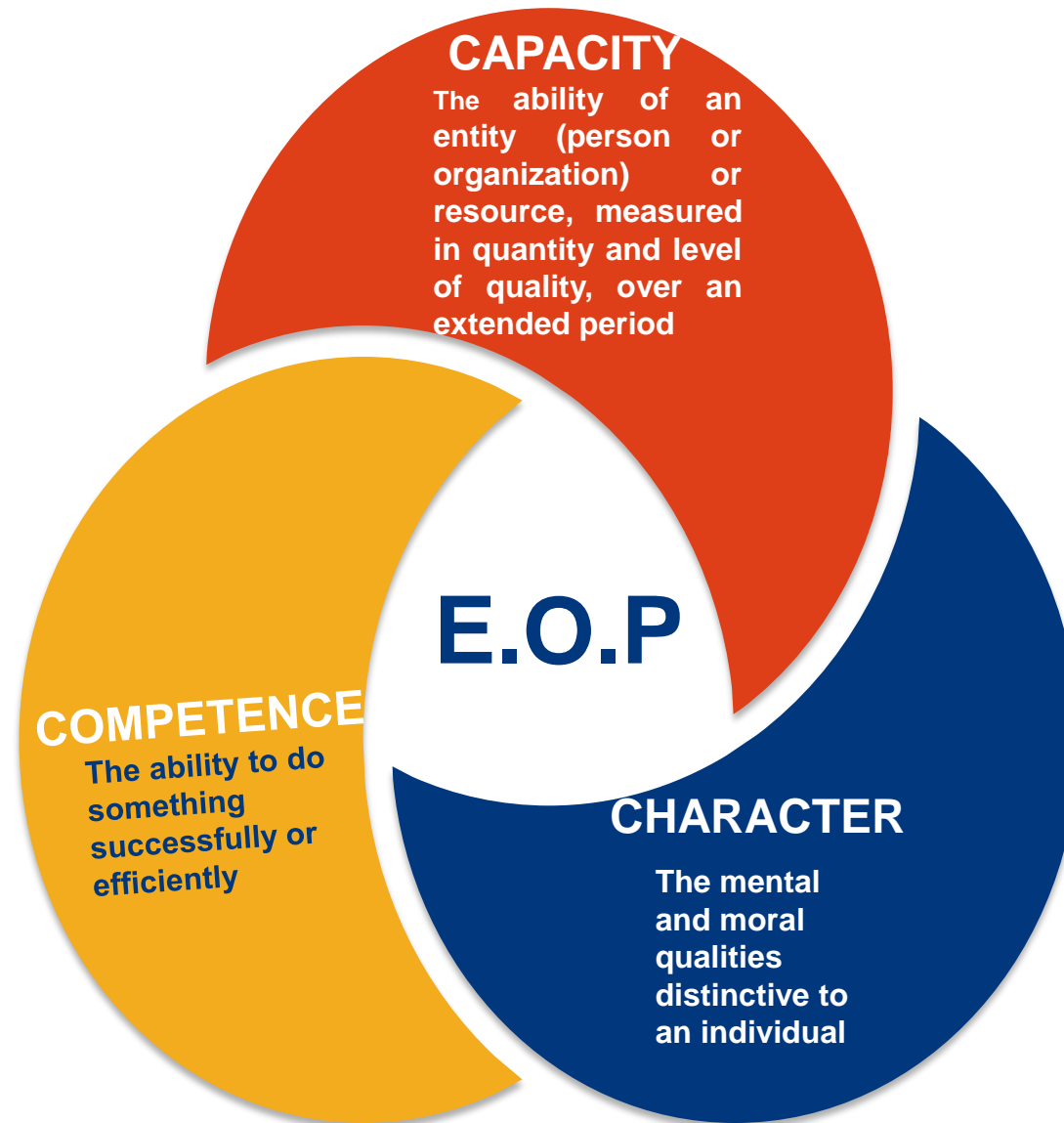
Deliberate Practice

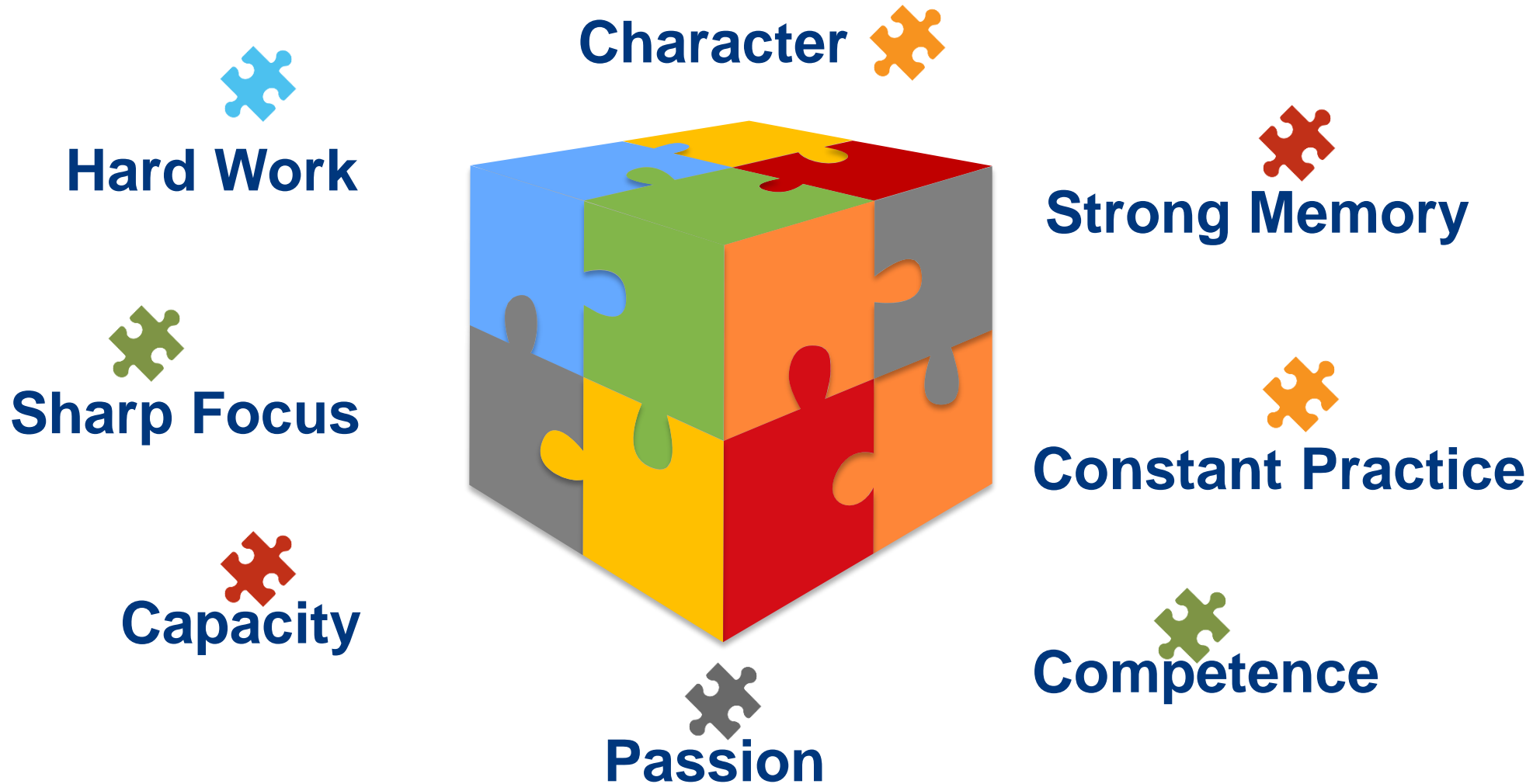

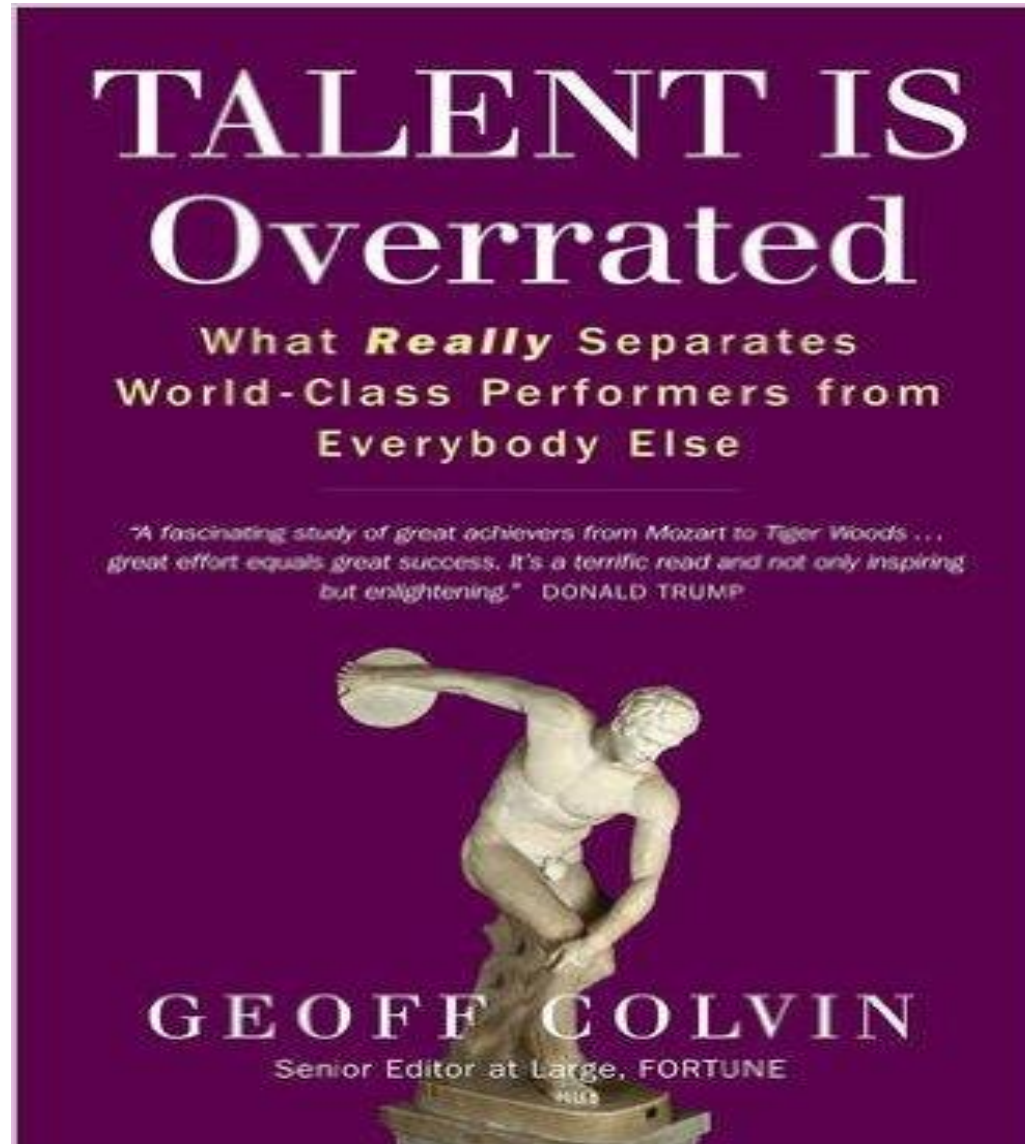
